

THE DOWNTOWN DISTRICT

Our downtown is the heart of the city where you can spend a day, a night or an entire weekend taking in the local flavor of Johnson City. Go from exploring our city's public art, local breweries, and restaurants to riding world-class mountain bike trails and hiking to incredible vistas—all within minutes of each other.

EATS & DRINKS

Johnson City takes eating and drinking seriously. While visiting, you should too. In downtown you'll find dozens of local restaurants, many offering international fare. And you won't leave thirsty – there are 6 breweries, a speakeasy, and several tap houses and bars to keep you quenched. Our walkable, historic downtown district allows for visitors to easily experience the craft brewery scene that has exploded in our region in recent years.



LIVE LIKE A LOCAL

When in Johnson City, do as the locals do and attend one of the many unique events downtown. Explore on two wheels and participate in the Taco Trek. This internationally recognized, casual paced biking event takes place the first Tuesday of the month April – October. Want to jam to some local tunes? Fridays After 5 is a free concert series in King Commons Park from May–July. Locals love our Farmer's Market on Saturday mornings from April – October, where you can buy produce, gifts, plants, coffee and more.

SEE THE SIGHTS, SIGN & SCAVENGER HUNT

You'll find art around every corner in Downtown Johnson City. There are a dozen murals, sculptures, an art walk, artistic wraps on traffic boxes and a seasonal art gallery. King Commons is best known for the Landmark Johnson City Sign, a photo opp must when in Johnson City. The park is also home to a passion flower sculpture and Wildabout mural. The mural inspired a scavenger hunt that features 15 bronze animal sculptures. Grab a clue card from a downtown business and search the district for a black bear, turtle, ladybug and more.




GO. ALL. OUT.





Andrew Johnson National Historic Site

Carter Mansion

On a quiet street in Elizabethton, the unpretentious but stately Carter Mansion sits back among old shade trees with the Watauga River in its backyard. The house was built between 1775 and 1780. It is believed to be the oldest frame house in Tennessee and the first house to have glass windows.

Clinchfield Railroad Museum

The museum also features a stage, which is used for performances and other functions.

Located in Historic Downtown Greeneville, the mansion was designed and constructed by two craftsmen from Ireland (1815–1821). The circular staircase, rising three full flights, is the "tour de force" of the builder's art. Built by William Dickson, Greeneville's first postmaster, for his only child, Catharine, this house served as headquarters for both Union and Confederate armies during the Civil War. Tours daily at 1 p.m. are limited to 12 people. Reservations required for groups over 12 people.

Doe River Covered Bridge

Stretching across the beautifully flowing, clear and cool water of the Doe River, Elizabethton's covered bridge is one of the town's premier and most photographed attractions. 


