

THE SNAKE RIDE About 116 miles, 42 Avg MPH, 02:47 Avg Time

The Snake Ride is the most popular and most difficult of all the Southern Dozen rides. In one 37 mile section, you'll take more than 480 curves while crossing three mountains. Take in the scenery as you snake through the Tennessee mountains to Stoney Creek and cross into the pastoral Shady Valley. From there, roar your way up to Backbone Rock, with outcroppings, hiking trails, and beautiful photo ops before returning through peaceful Mountain City.

TOP OF THE ROAN
About 100 miles, 39 Avg MPH, 02:32 Avg Time

Travel through historic Elizabethton to the top of Roan Mountain to experience panoramic views extending from Tennessee to North Carolina. Experience the world's largest natural stand of Catawba Rhododendron, which set the gardens ablaze in crimson hues in June during peak blooming season. This "Cloudland" is the perfect place to feel a cool breeze and let your mind wander back to a simpler time. After taking in this scenic landscape, turn things up a notch and get your heart racing as you head back to Johnson City on tight, winding roads.

PLACES OF THE PAST

About 74 miles, 41 Avg MPH, 01:47 Avg Time

Twist the throttle as you race around curves and switchbacks on this journey into the past to discover Northeast Tennessee's epic history. This ride takes you through Jonesborough, Tennessee's oldest town, where you can learn about the volunteers who saved the American Revolution, the homes of legendary pioneers, statesmen, and a U.S. President. Venture down cobblestone streets to the birthplace of Davy Crockett, past extraordinary museums, and even to a farm preserved since 1791.

4 8TH WONDER OF THE WORLD

About 91 miles, 56 Avg MPH, 01:37 Avg Time

Ride through Kingsport and into Virginia to check out what William Jenning Bryan called the "8th Wonder of the World". Natural Tunnel is more than one million years old and has been attracting visitors for more than two centuries. Park your bike and ride the chairlift down to hiking trails, picnic tables, and, of course, the incredible tunnel itself, and bask in wonder. If you're lucky, you may even spot a coal train passing through.

About 76 miles, 44 Avg MPH, 01:44 Avg Time

Northeast Tennessee and Southwest Virginia are famous for their music. Home to the legendary Carter Family and the Birthplace of Country Music, this area laid the foundation for America's modern music scene. Dine at the Burger Bar, visit the auditorium that June Carter and Johnny Cash called home, and see where the first "country" recordings were made in 1927.

SPELUNKER TOUR

About 57 miles, 43 Avg MPH, 01:19 Avg Time

Head Northeast to experience the region's most elaborate caves - the Bristol and Appalachian Caverns. There you'll discover a majestic underground river as you learn of the rich history of these caverns. Once a Native American escape route, then a Civil War refuge, the caverns have an array of stories to tell. On this ride, you'll have the opportunity to see these unique caves and explore an underground labyrinth more than one million years old.



VINEGAR PIE

About 152 miles, 47 Avg MPH, 03:15 Avg Time

This ride from Johnson City to Clinch Mountain is sweeter than it sounds - just like the Lookout Restaurant's Vinegar Pie, which you can try during your ride. Ride on the trails blazed by Daniel Boone and Davy Crockett and journey through some of East Tennessee's oldest communities. If the Vinegar Pie leaves you hungry, don't worry - you can feast your eyes on a panoramic view of Cherokee Lake and the foothills of the Smoky Mountains!

Rev your engines and enter the next chapter of this glorious ride, where you can visit the Moses Cone House, the Linn Cove Viaduct, or the various overlooks of Grandfather Mountain.

HOWLING WOLVES, STARS, & HISTORY

About 63 miles, 39 Avg MPH, 01:38 Avg Time

Whether you're traveling with the pack or howling up the road as a lone wolf, this ride holds a destination well worth the visit. Just a few twists of the throttle will take you to a land where wolves, deer, wild turkeys, and otters thrive alongside owls, beavers, and falcons. When you see the rippling, glistening water of the mountain lake, you'll know you've reached Bays Mountain Park.

EAST TENNESSEEHISTORY TOUR

About 34 miles, 36 Avg MPH, 00:58 Avg Time

Twist the throttle and travel back in time! Explore scenic roads on your way to the historic Rocky Mount, Tipton-Haynes, and the Sycamore Shoals Fort. Here you may even catch a historical reenactment, workshop, or other event steeped in regional history. On this ride, you'll also have the chance to see East Tennessee's oldest mansion and one of the country's last remaining covered bridges.
